Wallenberg Academy Fellow KAW 2023.0101

The board of the Knut and Alice Wallenberg Foundation has at its recently held meeting, decided to appoint Dr. Thomas Nordlander as Wallenberg Academy Fellow 2023 at Uppsala universitet.

The fellowship amounts to SEK 1 800 000 per annum, during five years. The university guarantees that a maximum of 50 % of the Fellow's salary will be charged to the grant.

The Fellows should be encouraged to participate in teaching.

Up to twenty percent of the grant can be used for indirect costs and rent. The university co-finances the grant with costs for premises and indirect costs, in addition to this level.

Reception of the grant confirms that these conditions are accepted by the university.

In addition, Thomas Nordlander will be provided with a start-up grant of SEK 3 000 000 provided that the university contributes with a similar amount in matching funds. The start-up grant should be specified in the budget and paid to Uppsala universitet as a complement to the grant.

Thomas Nordlander has also been awarded a relocation allowance of SEK 100 000 that will be paid to Uppsala universitet as a complement to the grant. The allowance is thereafter paid to Thomas Nordlander by Uppsala universitet and in accordance with applicable rules at the university.

The Foundation has commissioned the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences (KVA) and the Royal Swedish Academy of Engineering Sciences (IVA) to be responsible for the mentor program. Thomas Nordlander will be contacted by the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences regarding participation in the mentor program when the Foundation has received a confirmation that the offered grant will be accepted and by the Royal Swedish Academy of Engineering Sciences later on during the program.

Thomas Nordlander is required to submit a scientific report after two years and after five years, without further notice, and if applicable, including a list of publications, by e-mail to kaw@kaw.se.

The Foundation must be informed about the starting date within two weeks after receiving this letter and a budget on how the grant will be used must be sent to the Foundation at the latest one month before the project starts.

The budget form to be used is found on <https://kaw.wallenberg.org>. Starting date is 1 July 2024 or 1 January 2025. Contact person regarding budget and starting date is Caroline Morton (cm@wfab.se).

The grant will be paid to a bank account belonging to Uppsala universitet, after submission of a written requisition. The form for requisition to use is to be found on <https://kaw.wallenberg.org>.

All requisitions must follow the budget form applied by the Foundation and must be appropriately verified. For more information about the requisitions, please see <https://kaw.wallenberg.org>.

Before the first requisition, a list containing persons authorized to sign the requisitions must be submitted to the Foundation. This list must be signed by the principal investigator.


The Foundation has the right to follow up that the grant has been used for the stated purpose.
