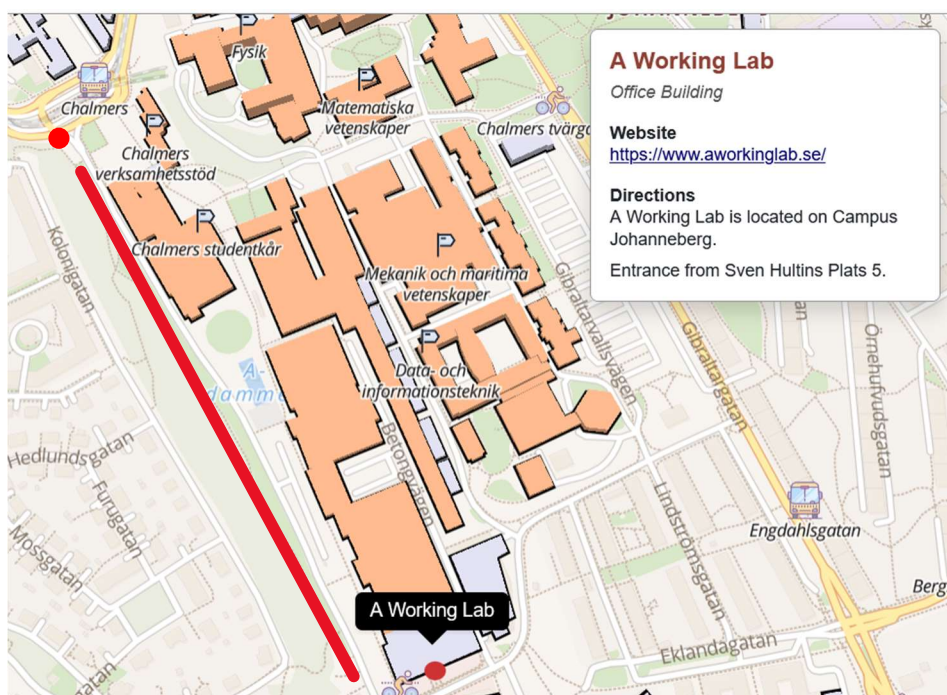
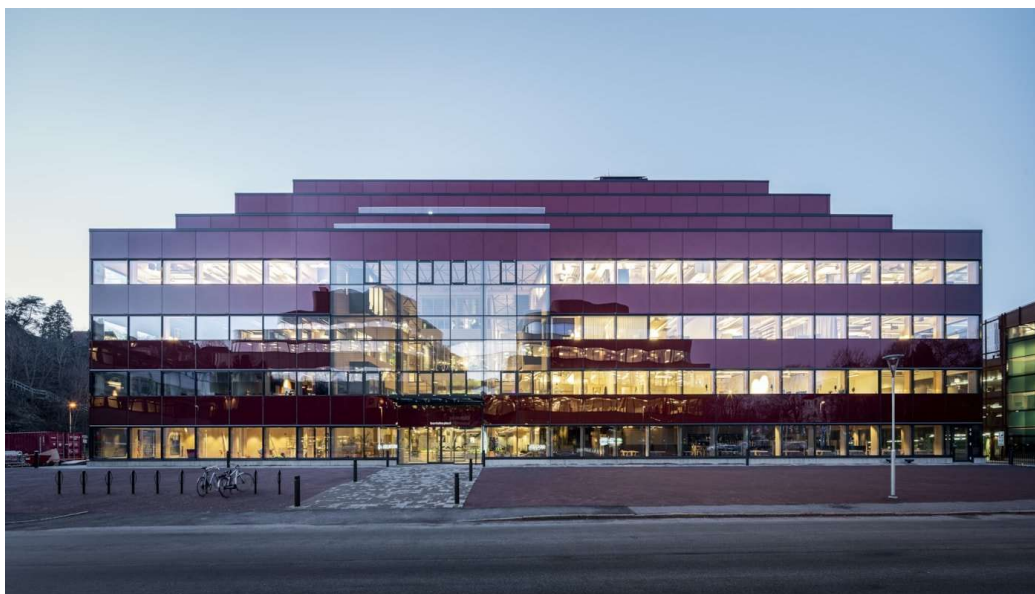


BASE 2.0 Kick-Off Meeting Gothenburg

The meeting will take place from 4-5 March 2025 at 'A Working Lab' (Sven Hultins Plats 5) on Chalmers Johanneberg Campus.

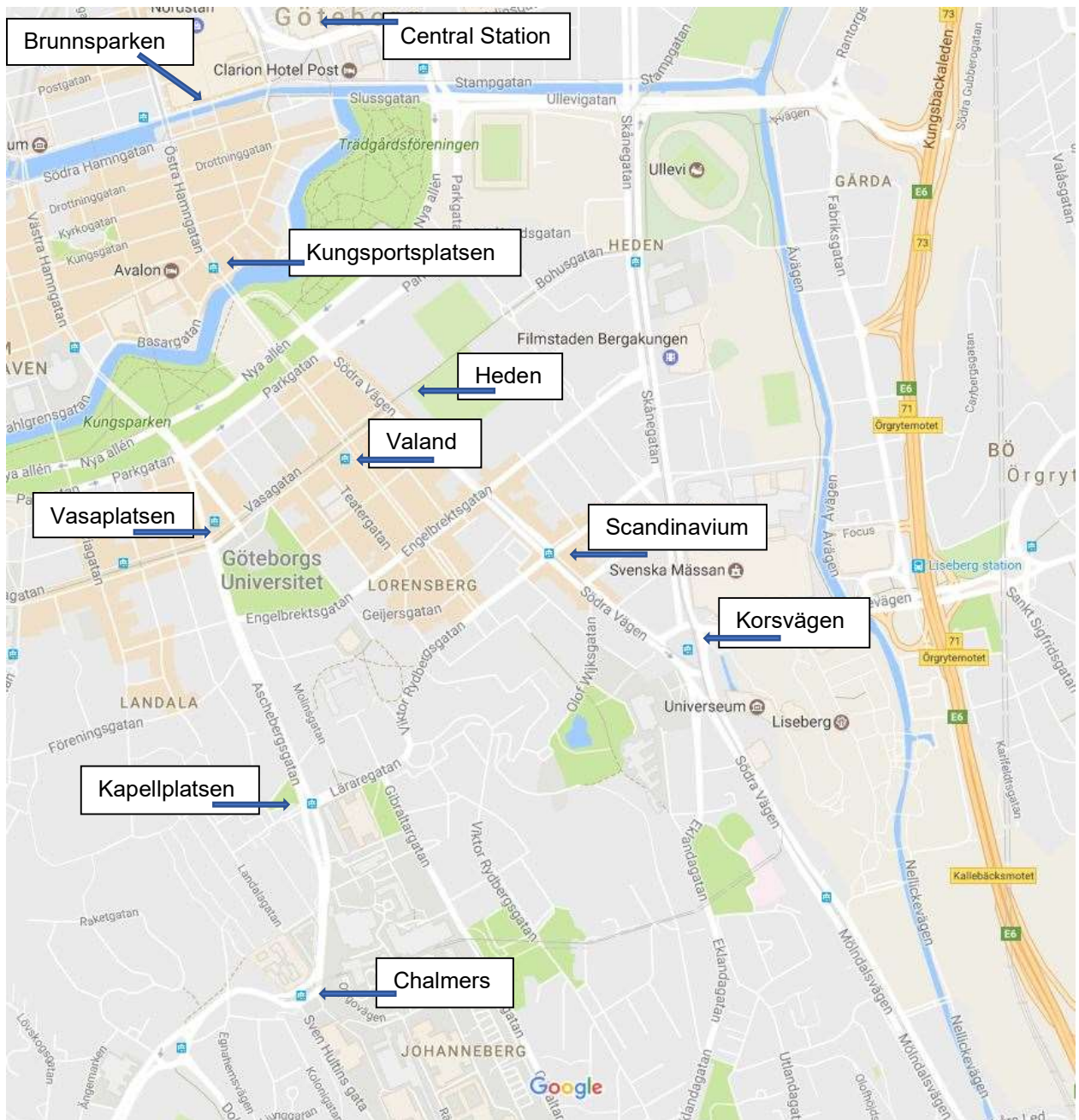


Information on trams and other public transportation [can be found here](#).

Tickets are sold in machines inside the trams, and they accept credit cards (VISA, Mastercard), but inside the buses the only way to buy tickets is by tapping your credit/debit card (more information [here](#)). Tickets are also sold via Västtrafik's [app](#) and at shops/kiosks such as Pressbyrå, SevenEleven or where you find the public transport company flag.



The following tram lines stop at Chalmers: 6, 7, 8, 10. Buses are: 16 and 753. From there it is approximately a 10-minute walk to the venue (see red line above).



Hotels in Gothenburg are many, however there are some that we recommend because they are fairly close to Chalmers: [Hotel Poseidon](#) and [Hotel Lorensberg](#) are family owned and smaller hotels. [Gothia Towers](#) is very centrally located and has 1200 hotel rooms. [Quality Hotel Panorama](#) and [Elite Park Avenue Hotel](#) are also good hotels and not too far from the campus.

Regarding taxis, we recommend Taxi Göteborg, phone +46 31 650 000.

The airport is Gothenburg Landvetter, airport code GOT. To get from the airport to the city the easiest is to take [Flygbussarna](#). The buses are frequent, and it is possible to buy the ticket online, at arrival at the airport and at the bus using credit card. The single ticket costs SEK 129 (online) and the return ticket costs SEK 239 (online). It takes approximately 25 minutes to central Gothenburg, stopping at places such as Korsvägen, Berzeliigatan, Kungsporsplatsen and Nils Ericsson Terminal/Central Station from where you can change to buses or trams.
