




### **Nuclear Physics**




















# Leadership and internal communication

- Division head = program professor.
- Division head link between division and department head.



- Regular meetings with division board.
- Weekly meetings for staff and students.
- Research activities

   organised in subgroups
   led by other senior faculty.





### Link division ↔ faculty of science

- Physics dean from NP (division head).
- Regular faculty colloquia.
- Regular newsletters from faculty.



- 2 out of 6 members of the physics electors from NP.
- The physics electors:
  - represent physics in the faculty electors' council
  - meet other electors once per month
  - take part in electing representatives in different university committees and boards
  - discuss faculty matters at small meetings and with other colleagues.










All senior faculty / researchers lead or co-lead a project.

...and active but "horizontal" interplay with division head






### Finances: costs

 $E = mc^2$ 

Expenses 2016 [MSEK]				
Personnel	Research	Premises	Total	
10.3 (58%)	6.2 (35%)	1.2 (7%)	17.7	

- Most senior faculty funded by faculty funding (teaching + research)
  - Teaching varies: 10%-25%
  - 2.5 researchers on external funding
- 6 PhD students faculty grants, 2 from external funding
  - Teaching ~10%

### **Finances: problems**

#### Swedish funding system:

- "Strategic funding" from government rarely directed to basic / curiosity driven research.
- External funding crucial
  - lack of continuity.
  - time scale of funding periods < time scale of research projects / commitments
- Writing applications very time consuming.
- Bibliometry a poor tool to evaluate Big Science.





### **Finances: possibilities**

- Increase efforts to obtain ERC grants
- Awareness at governmental/university level




### Issues

- Too much centralization of support
  - IT service.
  - Administrative routines cause a lot of work.
  - Procured products and services do not meet acceptable standards.
- Better integration between divisions
  - Regular colloquia.
  - Meetings about department issues.
  - Support structure for junior faculty
- Improve gender equality
  - Recruitment.
  - Awareness.
  - Summer school.



### Future

- Retirement of program professor 2018.
- The present structure of the division has been successful
   → Largest hadron physics group in Sweden
